Semi annual exam is doing well had an incident that involved his neck in October of 2020 is not having any clinical signs at this time

OBJECTIVE SECTION

Bright and alert, very active, does not want to hold still body score of 4.5 out of 9 mm are pink light tartar on his carnassial teeth heart sounds are normal is panting due to excitement but no obvious abnormal lung sounds eyes appear normal, pupils are equal and responsive both eyes equal in response to movement side to side and up and down I can clearly see both retinas ears: mild ofitis externa bilateral, mild grey exudate bilateral, suspect a yeast infection integument appears normal musculoskeletal system appears normal no discomfort on flexion and extension of his neck, or lateral movement to the right and left well muscled generalized no pain on flexion or extension of his hips stifles appear normal shoulders are well muscled, no discomfort on manipulation normal CP all 4 limbs normal tracking when walking straight and circling to either side Urogenital system appears normal, is intact

Diagnosis

suspect allergic otitis externa, will treat symptomatically with Zymox HC no obvious musculoskeletal or neurologic damage from his incident in October

I do not see any reason that Zuul should not be trained for police work

I will send home a bottle of Zymox HC to apply to both ears as prescribed on the label

Recommendations: 1) routine heartworm prevention (monthly or bi-annual Pro Heart injections) and appropriate flea/tick control (oral, topical, Seresto collar).

- 2) home dental care brushing with dog tooth paste, oral gel, TDC gel, Tartar Control diet or
- 3) regular exercise and stimulation away from the usual environment to keep your pet well rounded and in good body condition.
- 4) follow dietary recommendations to maintain a healthy body weight.
