EMERGENCY MEETING

Mayor Alexander and members of City Council met in a joint meeting with the Rowan County Board of Commissioners at 9:30 a.m. in Council Chambers at City Hall, 217 South Main Street. Members of the Rowan County Commission present were Chairman Greg Edds, Vice-Chair Jim Greene, Commissioner Mike Caskey, Commissioner Judy Klusman, and Commissioner Craig Pierce. Chairman Greg Edds provided the invocation.

Mayor Alexander indicated a need to adopt an Interlocal Undertaking Agreement with Rowan County.

Thereupon, Mr. Post made a **motion** to adopt a Resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute an Interlocal Undertaking Agreement with Rowan County and the Sheriff of Rowan County regarding mutual assistance of Law Enforcement Services. Mr. Miller seconded the motion. Messrs. Hardin, Miller and Post, and Meses. Alexander and Blackwell voted AYE. (5-0)



The Rowan County Board of Commissioners also adopted the agreement by unanimous vote.


Mayor Alexander thanked Chairman Edds and all those who worked to make the agreement possible. She noted the agreement is important to move forward to insure public safety.
