Mayor Klutz and members of City Council participated in a groundbreaking ceremony for Fire Station 50 at 11:00 a.m. on the future site of Fire Station 50, 2325 Statesville Boulevard.

The Presentation of Colors was conducted by Salisbury Firefighters and Fire Chief Bob Parnell welcomed those in attendance. Chaplain Dan Peters announced the roll call of departments and Chaplain Doug Stevens gave the opening invocation.

Mayor Klutz provided comments, noting that this is the first Fire Station to be built in Salisbury since 1957. Mayor Klutz, City Council members, City Manager David Treme, and Fire Chief Bob Parnell then participated in a ceremonial groundbreaking.
