Assessment & Plan				
Assessment:	*Diagnosis:  Overall healthy on exam today! I suspect that his shock collar was slightly too tight on his neck contributing to his harsher breathing especially when excited - I did loosen it a few notches to where it was still tight but I could get two fingers under it (good tightness level as want to be able to get finger-width between collar and neck for good fit). Let me know if you continue to see trouble breathing with Zuul now that we have changed this.			
Plan:	*Diet/recommendations: Continue his normal diet at home  *Vaccine reaction signs: swelling of face, skin hives, vomiting multiple times within a few hours of the vaccine. Call and let us know and if mild reaction you can give regular Benadryl (NO decongestant or NO artificial sweetener, active ingredient should be diphenhydramine): Dose: 62.5 mg (2.5 tablets of 25 mg regular Benadryl) and you can give every 8 to 12 hours as needed.  *Parasite prevention: Heartworm/intestinal worm: Continue Proheart Plus - he will be due in 6 months for his next injection. We discussed rechecking a heartworm test at that update to make sure he's confirmed negative for heartworm disease since he missed a few months before this injection - as long as negative then too he can then get Proheart 12 yearly.  Given R Shoulder SQ. ser:381691 exp:13/NOV/20  Flea/tick: Continue Credelio monthly - 1 chewable tablet by mouth every 30 days for flea/tick prevention. Give with food.  *Next Visit: Examination as needed if any problems arise; it was a pleasure seeing Zuul today!  Thank you for allowing us to care for Zuul!
