# Historic Preservation Incentive Grant meeting October 29, 2021 <br> Via Zoom

Staff: Emily Vanek
Emily Vanek explained the process and amount available. $\$ 20,000$ is available, and applicants can apply once per year. The points system consists of 4 criteria, Historic Significance, Project type, Project cost, Income.

## Applications, in order of receipt:

1. 402 S. Fulton St. - West Square Local Historic District - never submitted formal estimate, so ineligible
2. 507 S. Fulton St. - West Square Local Historic District - Repoint Brick, replace brick in carport. Project Cost: \$6,500 (41.5 points)
3. 425 W. Fisher St. - West Square Local Historic District - Replace flat roof section. Project Cost: \$9,000 (44 points)
4. 229 W. Bank St. - West Square Local Historic District - Replace iron fencing, retain granite posts. Project Cost: $\$ 8,488.30$ (33.4 points)
5. 428 N. Ellis St. - Ellis Street Graded School Local Historic District - Repair and replace soffits and fascia, window sills, replace wooden steps, repainting, installing gutters. Project Cost: \$14,000 (69 points)
6. 302 S. Ellis St. - West Square Local Historic District - Repair and replace soffit and fascia. Project Cost: \$2,695 (57.6 points)
7. 318 W. Thomas St. - West Square Local Historic District - Front porch roof repair and painting. Project Cost: \$5,100 (40.1 points)
8. 1016 Scales St. - North Main Street Local Historic District - Replace concrete steps, walkway, and replace rear door. Project Cost: $\$ 9,400$ (69.4 points)
9. 419 S. Ellis St. - West Square Local Historic District - Repair and repaint trim. Project Cost: \$3,800 (63.8 points)
10. 1013 N. Main St. - North Main Street Local Historic District - Add metal railings to steps, repaint green portions of house black. Project Cost: \$5,000 (40 points). According to tax records, not owner occupied.
11. 214 E. Bank St. - Brooklyn-South Square Local Historic District - Repaint, repair, and replace rotted wood. Project Cost: $\$ 1,000$ ( 36 points). Pre-civil war properties. Another address on property was painted only on the front. Owner says he'll be painting the entire building this time.
12. 126 E. Steele St. - North Main Street Local Historic District - Replace fencing. Project Cost: \$3,250 (28 points)
13. 527 W. Liberty St. - Ellis Street Graded School local Historic District - Replace driveway, fix drain in driveway, replace exterior stairs, railings, and paint. Project Cost: \$9,840 (44 points)

## Staff Recommendation

During the discussion, Ms. Vanek displayed the spreadsheet showing eligible amounts.
In reply to a question regarding grant history and whether or not that history plays into consideration of a current application, Ms. Vanek said that applicants can only receive a grant every other year. History is included to ensure applicants apply when eligible; it shouldn't be a factor in the Committee's decision.

After a discussion of methodology and different approaches to awarding funds, the Committee arranged applicants in order of point value and assigned amounts based on criteria. Since $\$ 20,000$ is available, the committee then adjusted the remainder among the applicants. They decided to award the lower income properties their full eligible amount.
